Please note: Students will be placed into the appropriate class level based on assessment of skills and technique along with consideration for the age guidance shown below. If a student is found to be between levels, they may be advised to take the lower level class as well as the higher level or they may benefit from private lessons to develop fundamentals. Our dancers move through the levels based on careful, constant and *individual* assessment throughout the year. We offer a complimentary trial/placement class for all prospective students.

***Pre-Pointe:** Open to Ballet III/IV students based on recommendation by the instructor

****Advanced Pointe:** Open to students with 2+ years of pointe training or upon invitation by the instructor

*****Students in Ballet III, IV and Advanced Adults may attend Pointe classes in soft ballet shoes to build strength and technical skills-adult dancers may also work toward the use of hard pointe shoes. Readiness for demi pointe and hard block pointe shoes will be assessed individually. Progression into “demi-pointe” (also called “soft block”) shoes will help to facilitate the transition to full pointe. Students will be invited to attend Variations class upon assessment.**

MOTUS Dance Company: Open to studio dancers ages 8-17. A dancer must be enrolled in at least one studio class to be eligible. We do not hold auditions for MOTUS. Sessions are held on Saturday afternoons-we will publish the MOTUS school year calendar with session and event dates and distribute it during the first company session of the school year (October 2021).

Adult dancers are welcome to join any class listed as “Open” or “Teen/Adult”. For placement consideration, our Open Ballet classes on Wednesdays and Saturdays are Intermediate/Advanced level. The best classes for beginners or dancers who have been away from ballet for an extended time are the “Adult Ballet Barre” (Tuesdays) or “Beginning Ballet” (Thursdays). Adults may pay on a per-class basis (\$15 drop-in fee) or purchase a class card (6 classes for \$72 or 12 classes for \$120). Class cards do not expire, and may be used for any of the aforementioned “Open” or “Teen/Adult” classes.
